The story so far

- Central Registry predates the RIRs
- Data inherited by ARIN
- Many registrants based outside North America
- AS Number transfer
 - Started August 2002
- IPv4 registration transfer
 - Started December 2002



IP space so far

- Former "Class B" networks
- 43 /8s transferred by April 2004



Plans for Stage 3 (1)

- Former "Class C" space
 - 192/8, 196/8 & 198/8
 - 3,000+ records to be transferred
 - 196/8 Registrations for African networks probably deferred until AfriNIC fully operational
- Two tranche process
 - -1st: 196/8 and 198/8
 - -2nd: 192/8 three month reply window



Plans for Stage 3 (2)

- Automation
 - -Faster web based response system
 - -No need to e-mail us
- Longer contact period
 - Three months to contact us then we merge objects if in both ARIN and RIPE databases
