# New Actions from RIPE48 DB-WG

## [AP-48.1 RIPE NCC & WW144]

Raise issue of making country: optional with the Address Policy working group.

## [AP-48.2 Shane Kerr, RIPE NCC]

To publish the requirements (for "joint whois") on the DB WG list.

## [AP-48.3 NT13]

Proposal (for poetry object) should be clarified and the minor issue of tech-c in the poetic-form object clarified.

# New Actions from RIPE48 DB-WG

## [AP-48.4 Randy and Niall]

To refine existing proposal (for abuse complaint contacts) to take into account the discussion during the session and try and achieve consensus on the mailing list.

## [AP-48.5 RIPE NCC]
